





INCAS and KTL have signed a Memorandum of Understanding in the field of aerospace testing and certification

INCAS – National Institute for Aerospace Research "Elie Carafoli" and KTL - Korea Testing Laboratory have signed a Memorandum of Understanding for research on aerospace testing and certification and to explore possibilities to work together in this field of expertise.

The MoU was signed at the INCAS headquarters in Bucharest by Mrs. Adriana Ştefan, President and CEO of INCAS and Mr. Jun-Kwang Song, General Director of KTL, on June 19th, 2024.



The purpose of the Memorandum of Understanding is to explore a commercial relationship and to seek possible collaborations on subjects such as:

- Research topics related to aerospace testing and qualification and certification of aircraft parts and/or systems;
- Exchange of information on laws and regulation for AAM and Drone Certification;
- Organizing conferences, workshops, seminars and/or events of networking and scientific and technology exchange between the scientists as well as other activities of common interest;
- Investigate opportunities for bi-lateral collaboration on topics of common interest and opportunities of collaboration in the frame of national and international projects or programs;
- Exchange information about scientific publications, conferences, trainings, seminars, aeronautical events and airshows as well as the possibility of personnel exchange or trainings for common interest defined topics.


